



RUSSIAN ROYAL

- Take a tour in the summer Residence of the Russian tsars accompanied by the court ladies' historical dresses;
- Take a lesson to learn the royal dances of the 18th century;
- Enjoy a picnic by the fountains and roses in the Royal park;

- Attend a royal ball and luxury dinner in a palace in the centre of Saint Petersburg;

Throughout the ages, the Russian Empire has been known as one of the biggest and strongest empires in the world, and royal families have always been associated with a luxurious lifestyle, gorgeous palaces and pompous celebrations.

During your visit to St. Petersburg, you'll be able to step into a noble's shoes and spend one day as the royal family did.

We will start your day with a visit to Catherine Palace – a masterpiece of Rococo architecture and the summer residence of Russian tsars. During the visit you'll be able to see the mysterious Amber Room, which was looted by the Nazis during WW2 and completely restored in 2003.

In the Palace Park, a true pearl of the 18th century Russian baroque architecture, you will meet court ladies dressed in historical dresses. They will offer you a welcome drink and will teach some traditional dances of the 18th century – to get you ready for evening's ball. After the dancing you will have a royal picnic lunch next to the one of the countless fountains surrounded by rose bushes.

Right after the picnic, horse carriages will be waiting at the park entrance and will take you for a short royal trip around the palace.

The day will finish at the Palace of Grand Duke Vladimir, located in the centre of St. Petersburg. Before visiting the palace, you will be able to choose your royal dress and suit for the evening's ball. Upon arrival you will be welcomed on the Palace stairs by violinists, and champagne will be served for each guest. All participants will have a short tour around the palace and it will finish with a master-class of royal dances – just to remind you of the steps you learned in the morning. We will continue your evening with a classical music concert - the program will include masterpieces of Russian classical music composed by the most famous local composers.

After the concert the doors to the private hall of the Palace will open and all the guests will be welcomed to sit down at the dinner table. Be ready to celebrate your day as royals do!
